Our Mission: Lekotek uses interactive play experiences, and the learning that results, to promote the inclusion of children with special needs into family and community life.

A Lekotek Overview

Lekotek provides direct services, support and information to children with special needs and their families in resource and play centers that can be found worldwide. The National Lekotek Center is a non-profit 501(C)3 organization based in Chicago, Illinois, and is the administrative and training center for a nationwide network of 32 Lekotek centers housing family play facilities, toy lending libraries and computer play resources. Through these special play and learning centers families can have fun with traditional toys, adapted toys, books and computers. And while they are playing, Lekotek kids are learning new skills that build the base for literacy, mathematical reasoning and computer use.

Clinical evidence affirms that early intervention using strategic play techniques profoundly affects a child's learning capacity. Play is how a child learns, and hidden in play are the keys to positive development. Lekotek provides each of our families with the guidance and tools to help their child with special needs develop through play. With the focus on the child's abilities - and not disabilities - Lekotek helps strengthen and support the entire family.

History

In the late 1970's, two American special educators, Sally deVincentis and Sharon Draznin, learned of the Lekotek concept at a conference in Scotland. They were so inspired by the idea that they traveled to Norway to receive training in Lekotek methods and they opened the doors to the first U.S. Lekotek in Evanston, IL in 1980. Today, nationwide, there are 32 Lekotek sites that offer family play sessions, toy lending libraries, Compuplay family computer centers, and other innovative community-specific programming. With the focus on what the child with disabilities can do, and with attention to the needs of the entire family system that supports the child, Lekotek plays an important role in helping children with disabilities reach their full potential.

How to Use the Directory

The Directory provides profiles of individual Lekotek programs including contact information, staff, services, age range, fees, availability of Spanish services, primarily population, number of average families served. Note that while Lekotek welcomes children of all abilities/disabilities, the primarily population listed highlights the predominate types of disabilities served by each center. Lekotek/Compuplay centers are listed geographically, under state then city. The index provides a quick way to find specific program information; alphabetically, by site name or location.

Some Definitions to help evaluate the information:

LEADER

Lekotek/Compuplay play specialist who is certified by the National Lekotek Center to work with families to make the world of play accessible to children with all types of disabilities.

SATELLITE SITE

A satellite Lekotek site is an adjunct program located in a site other than that of the primary Lekotek. Fiscal and administrative operations maintained by the primary site include: a permanent on-site toy inventory; service to less than 50 families, a Lekotek Leader, who works less than 3/4 time and operates less than 30 hours per week.

HOME VISITS

Play sessions provided in the client/family's home environment by specific locations and/or medical necessity.

PLAYGROUPS/CAMPS

Playgroups or camps includes at least 2 families up to 9 or 10 persons and must include at least one child and one parent or guardian. A camp includes 3 or more children and need not include a parent.

SERVICE BOUNDARY

The target area each Lekotek/Compuplay center services and where their clients reside.

HOME VISIT BOUNDARY

Geographical area defined by each Lekotek/Compuplay center where services can be provided in the home, if this service is provided by the site and if the client meets the center's specific criteria for home visits.

SLIDING SCALE

A scale to determine family Lekotek dues based on family income.

SCHOLARSHIPS

A waiver of regular family Lekotek fees due to a family's inability to pay.
